

Northwest Nassau Natural Gas Reliability Project

Overview

National Grid is making a multi-million dollar investment to modernize our natural gas system in Northwest Nassau County. This project, known as the Northwest Nassau Natural Gas Reliability Project, will help improve safety and reliability, and provide Long Island's gas system with greater operational flexibility. It will also improve the gas system's capacity to support economic growth.

Since the project started in June 2017, National Grid has installed two regulator stations in Roslyn Heights and approximately 1.82 miles of new gas main on the LIE North Service Road starting from Pinetree Lane in Old Westbury and ending on Jefferson Avenue in Roslyn Heights.

Next Phase Timeline*

In fall 2019, short-term gas main installation work resumed on Locust Lane, south of Saddle Lane. This work consists of trench excavation within the roadways followed by installation of the new gas main, temporary paving and, finally, restoration of the roadway. We anticipate completing work on this section this fall.

Our Commitment

We plan to construct the new infrastructure safely and reliably while acting as good neighbors and share information widely so that we can continue to serve our community well into the future. Throughout the project, we will make every possible effort to update our commercial and residential customers and other residents about upcoming actions, impacts and road closures, and maintain an open and proactive dialogue about the project with our neighbors and our partners in Nassau County.
